

**International cooperation for sustainable mobility - The 32nd Aachen Colloquium Sustainable Mobility will take place from October 09th - 11th at the Eurogress Aachen.**

As designers of the mobility of the future, it is our responsibility to pay particular attention to sustainable solutions. For this reason, the aspects of efficiency, safety and environmental friendliness will again be comprehensively examined in relation to various mobility topics this year. As always, networking and international exchange between industry and science will be a particular focus. We are looking forward to welcoming you again in Aachen and offering you an interesting platform for the exchange of experts from research and industry worldwide.

From October 09th - 11th, 2023, you will have the opportunity to attend 100 technical presentations. The speakers will present research results and innovations from various, highly topical areas, such as digitalization, automatization, hydrogen applications, electrification, driving dynamics and mobility "out-of-the-box". In the detailed lecture overview, you will find all the information about the sessions. Not only in the lecture hall, but also on the road there will be sustainable mobility to touch. The Circus Minimus offers you the opportunity to experience new vehicle concepts and innovative operating strategies, which rely on the amplification of muscle power through e-motors, directly in front of the Eurogress. This will give you an impression of future developments in micromobility.

The 32nd Aachen Colloquium will begin on October 9th at 6:00 p.m. (CEST) with an opening speech by the two organizers, Prof. Lutz Eckstein from the Institute of Automotive Engineering (ika) and Prof. Stefan Pischinger from the Chair of Thermodynamics of Mobile Energy Conversion Systems (TME) at RWTH Aachen University, and with the opening of the accompanying exhibition. The lecture program will start on October 10th at 08:30 a.m. with a plenary session in which Mr. Arnd Franz, CEO of MAHLE, will speak on "Efficiency in Motion - Holistic Efficiency Improvements with Solutions from Mahle". Mr. Mehmet Gürcan Kaarakaş, CEO of Togg, will then talk about #redefining Mobility. Following this, Mr. Atsushi Ogawa, COO Innovative Research Excellence at Honda Motor R&D, will give a presentation on Honda's Challenge: Carbon Neutrality, Zero Accidents, and New Mobility Areas Leveraging Core Technologies. The plenary session will be concluded by Dr. Frederik Zohm, Executive Board Member for Research and Development at MAN, with his topic: "MAN on the way to CO2-free transportation".

In the closing plenary discussion on October 11th, starting at 3:40 p.m., Dr. Matthias Jurytko, CEO of Cellcentric, Dr. Peter Laier, Member of the Board at ZF Group, and Gerrit Marx, CEO of IVECO Group, will jointly share their expertise and assessments on the topic of "Sustainable Transportation from an ESG Perspective" with the audience. We are looking forward to the exciting and insightful exchange!

More than 40 well-known companies will present their competencies, concepts and components at the trade exhibition. The exhibiting companies are also available online, enabling participants to expand their network and exchange ideas in exciting discussions.
